

Priority basic principles:

1. Political and legal area:

- Delimitation of competences and scope of managements among the central authorities of the country and those of the autonomy;
- Passing some legislative acts aiming at achieving the socialeconomic objectives;
- Approving the Strategy for Sustainable Economic Development of Găgăuzia.

2. Economic development:

• Structural transformations:

attracting investments, creating industrial parks, small and medium business development, implementing the renewable energy sources, developing the mechanisms of public-private partnership, providing some additional tax facilities for investors.

2. Economic development:

Development of the infrastructure:

road rehabilitation, implementation of water supply projects, completing the Gasification Program, implementation of environmental projects.

3. Economic development:

Rural development of Găgăuzia:

implementation of the Program for sustainable rural development of Găgăuzia, improving the life quality in Gagauz villages, ensuring the access to public services, infrastructural development and modernization in the villages of Găgăuzia.

3. Agriculture:

- to approve the program for assisting the agricultural manufacturers in the autonomy;
 - to create the seeds fund of the autonomy;
 - to modernize the food industry;
 - to stimulate the development of zootechnic sector;
 - to promote the goods with high added value;
 - to strengthen the consulting system in agriculture.

4. Education:

- legislative regulation of relationship between educational institutions and local public authorities;
- to optimize the training-educational process in kindergartens, gymnasiums and high-schools;
- to resolve the issue of ensuring the young teachers with housing;
- to improve the technical-material basis of the educational institutions.

5. Medicine:

- to strengthen the technical-material basis of curative-preventive institutions;
- to improve the life and housing conditions of the medical personnel;
- to attract the qualified medical staff;
- to assist in increasing the qualification level of medical staff;
- to carrying out an adequate control over the prices for drugs.

6. Providing jobs and social protection to population:

to approve a comprehensive employment program;

- to implement some additional measures concerning the social protection of citizens working abroad;
- to involve some qualified medical staff in the activity;
- to ensure the observance of employees' right to work;
- to provide nominal social aid for impoverished categories of the population.

7. Culture:

- to ensure the activity of all culture houses;
- to re-establish the activities of cinema halls;
- to develop the autonomy's museums;
- to support the popular crafts, creative teams (professionals and amateurs);
- to promote the gifted people of Găgăuzia on national and international level.

8. Policy on youth, physical culture and sports:

- to developing the Program for providing assistance to the youth in Găgăuzia and the Program for assisting the young entrepreneurs;
- to strengthen the community youth movement;
- to create an entrepreneurship incubator based in the State University of Comrat;
- to provide employment support to graduates of the State University of Comrat;
- to create resource centres for youth;
- to create sport & curative objects and to modernise the existing ones.
