Law No. 985-XV of 18.04.2002

Article 181. Obstruction of the exercise of the right to vote or activity of the electoral bodies

Any form of obstruction of the free exercise of the electoral rights or obstruction of the activity of electoral bodies involving:

- a) any form of obstruction or attack on precincts;
- b) theft of voting boxes and electoral documents;
- c) jeopardising the life of individual;
- d) carried out along with infliction of serious body damage;
- e) having other serious consequences

is punished by a fine worth 200 to 400 conventional units or by 180 to 240 hours of unpaid community work or by imprisonment up to three years.

Article 182. Falsification of Voting Results

(1) Voting of a person: without having this right, either once or twice, either by introducing in the ballot box more ballots than he/she has the right to, or by using a fake ID card or a fake ballot

is punished by a fine worth 200 to 400 conventional unit or by 100 to 200 hours of unpaid community work, or by imprisonment up to 2 years.

(2) Falsification of voting results, by any means,

is punished by a fine worth 300 to 500 conventional units or by 180 to 240 hours of unpaid community work, or by imprisonment up to three years.
