Criminal Code (excerpts)

(Law N 985-XV from 18.04.2002)

Article 181. Obstruction of the exercise of the right to vote or activity of the electoral bodies

Any form of obstruction of the free exercise of the electoral rights or obstruction of the activity of electoral bodies involving:

- a) any form of obstruction or attack on precincts;
- b) theft of voting boxes and electoral documents;
- c) jeopardising the life of individual;
- d) carried out along with infliction of serious body damage;
- e) having other serious consequences

is punished by deprivation of freedom for a term of two to five years.

Article 182. Forgery voting results

Forgery of any form of the voting results

is punished by a fine of 200 to 400 conventional units or unpaid work for the community benefit from 180 to 240 hours, or deprivation of freedom for a term of up to five years.
